

Anatomy of a Testimonial Post

These items show in the site footer and on certain landing pages. **Even those this is called a Testimonial Post, you can use this space for advertising or other text/image.** Keep in mind that the CMS pulls a item from the Testimonial bank at random each time a page is loaded. Each of these color items must be addressed BEFORE publishing a Testimonial Post.
