


Placing a Video


The easiest way to place video in the content is to first upload your video to YouTube, once that is complete you use YouTube's share options to embed the video in the website's content.

Options found under the 'Share' button...

Within the CMS go the page you want to embed the video into. From the normal edit page, click the HTML tab in the upper right corner. Here is where you view your content in code form. You will see various programming tags that appear within < > symbols. Scroll down until you see where you'd like to place the video, then paste the YouTube code in that place.

Then type...

?wmode=transparent at the end of the video URL just inside the quotation mark. This ensure that the embed code will not disrupt the site's layout.
